Publishing Rules (English)

This Journal has the following parts:

1. Studies
2. Materials
3. Synthesis
4. Recovery/re-evaluation of old discoveries and collections
5. Book reviews, notes, discussions

General recommendations:

Text:

1. Please send the texts formatted with Times New Roman fonts, at 1.5 space, with the following sizes: article title – size 14; article text – size 12; key-words, abstracts, references – size 10.
2. Please send the text in format .doc or .docx, A4 format paper.
3. The illustration should be sent in separate files, not in a Word, PDF document or included in the text.
4. Each article must have an abstract in Romanian and one translated into English, along with and five keywords in Romanian and translated into English.
5. Authors are asked to specify their institutional affiliation and email address.

The references:

1. These will include the author's name, year, page and will be inserted in round brackets, at the end of the sentence/paragraph, like: (Necrasov 1990, p. 78).
In the case of an author with several contributions from the same year, the separation will be made by adding a letter after the year, like: (Cristescu 2001a; Cristescu 2001b).
In the case of a contribution with at least three authors, the name of the first author will be mentioned, followed by *et alii*.
2. We recommend using the full name of the journal and not the abbreviated form.

3. Article in a Journal:

Cantemir, Botezatu 1995: P. Cantemir, D. Botezatu, *Caracterizarea antropologică a populației feudale de la Gherăești (jud. Neamț)*, *Studii și Cercetări de Antropologie* 32, 1995, p. 3-7.

4. If a work has three or more authors, the bibliographic reference in brackets will be made with the abbreviation *et alii*, and all authors will be included in the bibliographic list.

Paine *et alii* 2007: R. R. Paine, D. Mancinelli, M. Ruggieri, A. Coppa, *Cranial trauma in Iron Age Samnite Agriculturists, Alfedena, Italy: Implications for Biocultura land Economic Stress*, *American Journal of Physical Anthropology* 132, 2007, p. 48-58.

Illustration (color or black and white):

1. For each illustration, the mention in text will be inside round brackets (Fig. 1, Graphic 1, Tabel 1).

2. The list of figures must be at the end of the article, in the original language of the article and in English.

3. The illustration can be conceived both in the form of drawings and smaller figures, which will be included in the text.

4. The text related to the illustration (numbering the component parts of a sheet, names of localities on a map created by the author, etc.) must be written in Times New Roman, font size 10.

5. The illustration must be sent in JPG or TIFF format, minimum 300 dpi resolution, as well as in Corel Draw (.cdr) format.

6. The graphics must be included in the text and sent also in excel format (.xls or .xlsx).

7. The tables must be submitted in .doc or .docx format.
